- **Store Documents in the Cloud:** The ScanSnap S1300i also has the ability to scan directly into cloud-based storage solutions such as Dropbox, GoogleDocs, SugarSync, Evernote and Salesforce Chatter.
- **“ScanSnap Folder”:** The “ScanSnap Folder” replicates ScanSnap as a Windows folder, allowing users to automatically attach or upload files from the ScanSnap

- **Grayscale Scanning:** The ScanSnap S1300i now scans images or text in grayscale mode, in addition to automatically detecting color and monochrome.
- **Document Processing:** The ScanSnap S1300i has the capability to automatically detect paper size, orientation and blank pages. It can scan documents up to 34 inches in length and comes with a 10-page, letter-size automatic document feeder.
