Isabella Grabner, Ph.D., an associate professor of accounting at Maastricht University School of Business and Economics, Netherlands, has been named the recipient of the 2016 Best Early Career Researcher Award.

The award, presented by the [American Institute of CPAs \(AICPA\)](#) and the [Chartered Institute of Management Accountants \(CIMA\)](#), recognizes the best overall body of research in management accounting and is sponsored by the AICPA and CIMA on behalf of the Chartered Global Management Accountant (CGMA) designation. It is granted in collaboration with the Management Accounting Section of the American Accounting Association (AAA).

Grabner was honored with the award at the annual AAA Conference in New York. It was presented on behalf of the selection committee, chaired by Geoff Sprinkle, Ph.D., professor at the Kelley School of Business, Indiana University.

Grabner's research uses insights from labor economics to explore performance measurement and incentive systems. Her research includes analysis of effort-based versus risk-based incentives and the choice of performance measures in promotion decisions. The award is accompanied by a \$2,000 grant.
