The new apps will support mobile devices running BlackBerry 6, Android, and Windows Phone 7 operating systems. Last year, DocuWare released its apps for Apple's iPhone, iPad and iPod Touch. Features of DocuWare Mobile include continuous access to all files, secure and controlled access, an integrated stamp feature, and the ability to search documents, workflows and tasks.
