

The Internal Revenue Service is offering reduced cost "early bird" registration for all five 2019 IRS Nationwide Tax Forums ends June 15 at 5 p.m. Eastern time.

The IRS hosts forums across the country to interact with tax professionals and provide the latest information on federal and state tax issues. Attendees who register by 5 p.m. Eastern time on June 15 qualify for the early bird rate of \$235. After this time, the standard rate of \$255 is in effect until two weeks before each location's event. Attendees registering less than two weeks before a forum or on-site will pay \$370.
