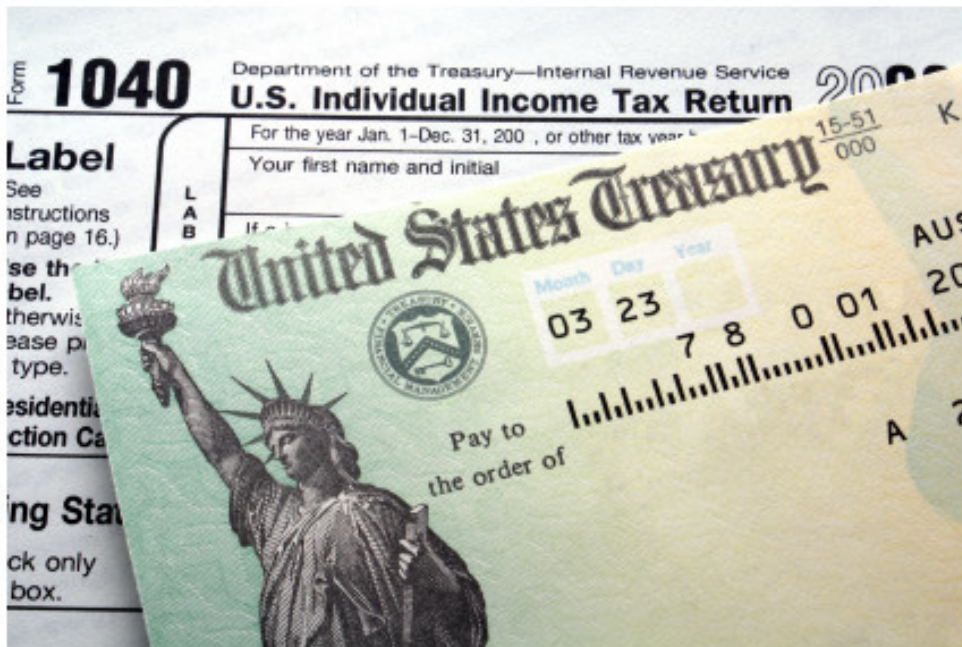

This is 2021, and the deadline for income taxes to be filed in the U.S. is again April 15, 2021. But even after a year of living with COVID's effects, shutdowns and remote working, many tax professionals think another overall tax season extension, as happened last year, could be beneficial.

Survey findings include:

- 73% of respondents expect the lack of guidance from the IRS on new tax provisions related to COVID-19 relief to be the biggest challenge for 2021.
- 66% of respondents expect the biggest challenge for taxpayers in the 2021 filing season to be understanding the tax impacts of COVID-19, including the economic impact payments, COVID distributions and the earned income credit.
