Starting in 2017, I directed CPA Evolution, an effort to transform the CPA licensure model to recognize the rapidly changing skills and competencies the practice of accounting requires. Working with AICPA and NASBA leadership, I worked to redesign the CPA license to a core + disciplines model, ultimately garnering overwhelming support from the profession and regulatory community.
