The New Jersey Society of Certified Public Accountants (NJCPA) has awarded 10 of its members \$750 each towards their CPA Exam fee costs. The CPA Exam Fee Lottery winners, who were either student or CPA candidate members, were selected at random out of nearly 70 entries.

This year's lottery coincides with New Jersey's **CPA Week**, which was designated to be November 6 through 12 by New Jersey Senate Resolution (**SR101**). The resolution was sponsored by Senator Steven Oroho (R-24) — the only CPA in the Legislature — and Senate President Nick Scutari (D-22).

The annual lottery, which launched in 2019, is designed to partially offset the cost of preparing for and taking the CPA Exam. Review courses, study guides and other prep work, along with the actual cost of the Exam, can average more than \$2,500.
