The Big Four firm noted that it had steady growth across all regions, with the Americas reporting 16% growth, followed by Asia Pacific with 13% growth and the Europe, Middle East and Africa (EMA) region with 11%.

In addition, all three of KPMG's core service lines—advisory, tax and legal, and audit—had year-over-year revenue growth.

The KPMG global organization’s worldwide headcount continued to grow in 2022, increasing by 12.4%, bolstered by more than 29,000 net new roles created. The firm also noted that women represent 48.5% of all KPMG professionals around the world.
