The Community FoodBank serves 15 counties in the state, distributing food to charities, soup kitchens, emergency shelters, food pantries and other places of need. It provides more than 90 million meals through its network every year.

The food drive is hosted by the NJCPA Emerging Leaders Council, an appointed leadership group that addresses the needs of NJCPA members with up to 10 years of experience, including aspiring CPAs and new licensees. The Council is looking to meet or exceed 2022's collection of approximately 2,500 pounds of nonperishable items and canned goods and more than \$35,000 in monetary contributions. Since 2010, the NJCPA has donated more than 20,000 pounds of food to the FoodBank.
