Students who apply should be enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student, be an accounting major or have expressed an interest in an accounting career, and identify as an ethnic minority.

"The Accounting Scholars Leadership Workshop provides the opportunity for them to see the immense potential of a career in accounting from professionals who come from similar backgrounds and want to see them succeed. They can make lifelong connections with like-minded peers and seek out invaluable mentors who can guide them throughout their career journey."
